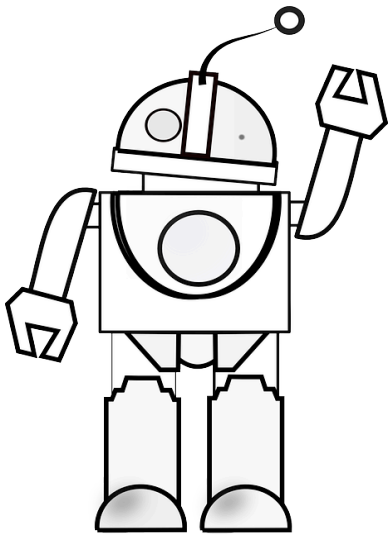

What is this study about:

This study will explore youth's experiences and impact of the *HB FIRST*® program to understand how the program can support social inclusion and science and technology-based learning for youth with disabilities.

Who can participate?

We are looking for children and parents enrolled in the *HB FIRST*® robotics program at Holland Bloorview. This includes:

- Children aged 6-14
- Children with physical or developmental disabilities; and
- Children who have an interest in LEGO® or robotics

What's involved?

The study involves:

- Observation / video recording of child participation during the *HB FIRST*® robotics workshops;
- Pre- and post-surveys (approximately 20 minutes each)
