Music and art programs

We offer fee-for-service music and art programs for children and youth with special needs, up to the age of 21. Children without special needs are welcome to register for Spiral Garden.

- Group or 1:1 music therapy and adapted music education
- Spiral Garden (integrated program for participants with and without special needs)

Integration at Spiral Garden summer day program

Participants with and without special needs come to the program as one group. There are opportunities to participate in both small and large group activities, some more structured and others more self-directed. It creates ample opportunity for making new friends and learning about each other. If needed, staff are always around to help facilitate conversations and interactions in the celebration of all that makes us different and unique.

Music and art meet and greet

Our programs take place in many different settings that are sometimes open and busy with a limited amount of staff support. If your child is new to music and art, you and your child will be asked to come in for an in-person visit prior to a spot being confirmed in any of these programs. This will allow us to understand your child's needs and which programs we can best support them in. It is also a great opportunity to:

- Learn more about the program
- See what your child can expect from their time in the program
- Ask and answer questions

This will help us determine if we can provide a spot for your child in your program of choice with the necessary staff support. We will contact you to set up a time to meet for approximately 30 minutes.

Confirming your child's spot

After we receive your registration form and payment, you will get a confirmation of receipt. A meet and greet visit will then be scheduled, if needed. After the meet and greet visit, you will receive confirmation of your child's spot. We will inform you if we are able to meet your child's support needs in your program of choice. There may be a need to suggest a different program option or place children on the wait list if all supported spots are filled.

*For Music programs confirmation of a spot will be sent beginning the week of May 31, 2019. For Spiral Garden: confirmation of a spot will be sent beginning the week of April 7, 2019. Applications received after these dates will be held on the wait list for any available spots.

Cancellation policy

To receive a refund, participants must withdraw from a seasonal program at least two weeks prior to the program start date. A \$50 service charge will be deducted. For cancellations less than two weeks prior to the start of the season, the full program cost will be charged.

Once enrolled, staff will work with the client and family to ensure their identified support needs are met. However, when all possible avenues have been exhausted, it may be determined that we are unable to meet their needs and participation in the program is not able to continue. Any decision such as this will be made in collaboration with family, clients, program staff and the program manager.

Session start and end dates will vary depending on participant's schedule. 6 weeks + make up week. There will be no programs August 3 – 5.

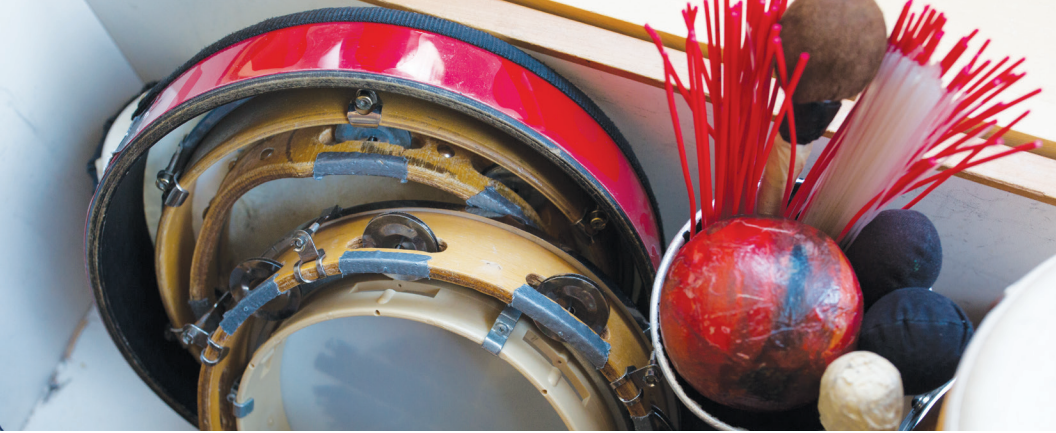
Music therapy

Our music therapy programs specialize in the purposeful use of music to support development, health and well-being within cognitive, communicative, emotional, musical, physical and social domains. Music psychotherapy with a Registered Psychotherapist is available. Please speak with our team for more information.

Adapted music education

Learn to play an instrument! Clients can choose from a variety of instruments and innovative adapted music technology. Instruments include: the Virtual Musical Instrument (VMI)*, piano, guitar, voice, violin, percussion and ukulele. Our instructors use a variety of teaching methods and techniques for success-oriented music experiences.

*The VMI is music software developed at Holland Bloorview. The program allows musicians to see themselves on a TV screen with colourful shapes and objects that make different musical sounds when touched. When the musician moves through the shapes on the screen, music is produced.

Spiral Garden summer day program

Spiral Garden is an integrated outdoor, art, garden and play program that takes place in the scenic, 1.5 acre garden site at Holland Bloorview. Participants are free to explore the garden, playing and creating in activities that may include paint, clay, sand, water play, story, puppetry, dress-up, music, woodworking, cooking and garden activities.

Since 1984, Spiral Garden has been bringing participants with and without special needs together to foster an inclusive community that values the whole person, promotes self and group expression and builds a fun and hands-on relationship with nature and art.

We are able to provide one-to-one support on a limited basis for participants up to age 18 (no additional cost). Please make your request for this support on the registration form.

Age: 6 – 18 Participants must turn 6 on or before December 31, 2019.

A limited number of spots are available in each session for participants aged 19 – 21.
