## **Referral to Baby CIMT:**

Online referral can be accessed by clicking **here**. Indicate Baby CIMT on the referral and identify the community service(s) involved including name of the clinician(s).

## **Referral criteria:**

- The infant lives in Toronto or Greater Toronto Area.
- The infant is between the ages of 4-21 months.
- The infant has asymmetrical hand use, has a diagnosis of, or is identified to be at risk of, hemiplegic cerebral palsy.
- The infant is involved with community services (i.e. OT, PT, EI).

### About the Baby CIMT Clinic:

The clinic provides assessment to infants who are at risk of, or who have a diagnosis of hemiplegic cerebral palsy. Clinicians will receive consultation and support for implementation of Baby CIMT. The clinic provides no active therapy.

- Consultation and recommendations for Baby CIMT
- Clinician (OT, PT, El) receives :
- consultation and support for implementing Baby CIMT home program
