What is this study about:

- Youth transition readiness refers to youth having the behaviours and skills necessary to live their adult lives as part of their community.
- Our goal is to find out what Holland Bloorview's parents/guardians think about their children's transition readiness.
- Parents/Guardians should participate because it may help Holland Bloorview to know where families are at, and because it may get you thinking about things you have not thought of before.

Who can participate?
