<b>Is one-on-one support provided:</b>	We do not provide 1:1 staffing, but we do welcome campers who come with a support worker from home
<b>What changes to your programming have you implemented due to COVID-19?</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Most importantly, we are committed to opening safely this summer, even if it means camp policies, procedures and activities may be different</li> <li>• We will update you about how COVID will affect camp, as soon as we receive information or change policies</li> <li>• Most senior staff from 2019 has signed up for 2021 – which means that we have experience and talent to adjust camp for COVID – and still give campers the summers of their lives</li> <li>• We are hiring more cleaning staff this year than in the past. Cleaners will sanitize cabins, washrooms, the dining hall, and all high traffic areas three or more times each day.</li> <li>• We are installing outdoor wash sinks throughout camp to ensure campers have no excuse not to wash their hands often.</li> <li>• We will adhere fully to all guidelines</li> </ul>

The OCA is developing its camp guidelines in association with doctors at Sick Kids Hospital in Toronto to ensure that they are both effective and are right for our campers.
