<b>What precautions have you put in place to ensure that your program will continue if there are changes in provincial pandemic requirements?</b>	We are proud to say we hosted 599 campers, and approximately 100 volunteers in 2021 with 0 cases of covid. We follow all Ontario Association Covid-19 Guidance which was developed with the Ontario Ministry of Health, as well as the protocols set out by the Peterborough Public Health Dept. These have included rules such as, all programming held outdoors when possible, no sharing of equipment and no mixing of Cabin Cohorts. Activities that must be held Indoor for weather or other reasons were used by only one cohort

	at a time and any shared or high touch areas must be cleaned and disinfected before and after use. We used coloured sports pinnies worn at all time to identify the different cohorts so as to insure that they do not mix.
