


# Staff symptomatic flowchart- December 2022

1. Call the AWAY line (x3020)  
 2. Contact manager/department to report absence  
 3. Provide a list of staff, clients, volunteers, students etc that you were in contact with in the 48h period prior to your symptoms starting to Occupational Health for contact tracing  
 4. Monitor symptoms  
 5. You can return to work onsite on day 7 if your symptoms have been improving for 24h (48h for GI symptoms)  
 \*provide a copy of any PCR test results to Occupational Health

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# High Risk Exposure Flowchart- December 2022

1. You can return test to work immediately if you are asymptomatic  
2. Pick up RAT tests from Main Reception and complete a test daily prior to coming onsite for 10 days from date of last exposure.  
3. You DO NOT need to call the AWAY line if you have no symptoms  
4. Wear a well fitted medical mask (or N95 mask if working with clients) and follow IPAC protocols.  
5. If symptoms develop, refer to the **symptomatic flowchart** for next steps.  
\*PCR testing no longer required

1. You can return to work immediately if you are asymptomatic  
2. Self monitor for symptoms for 10 days from date of last exposure

What is a high risk exposure?
