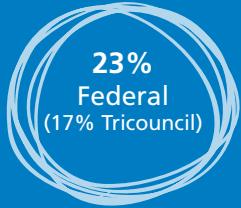

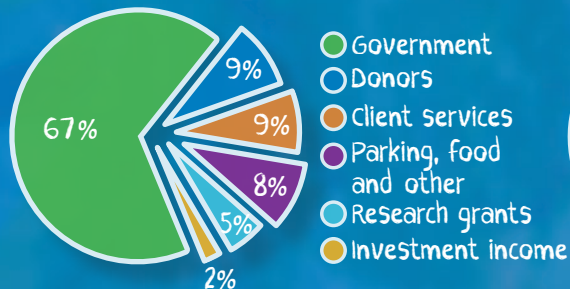

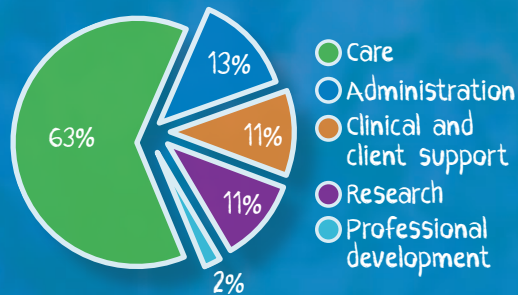
where do hospital funds come from?



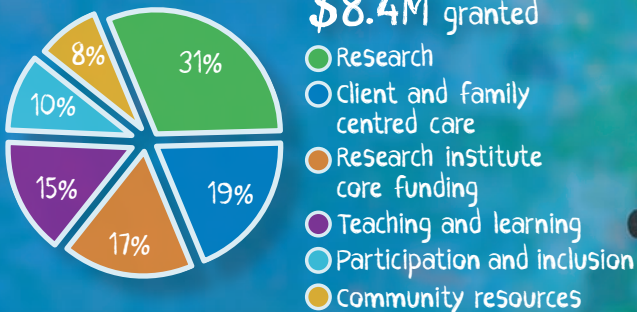
where do foundation funds come from?
