Concussion Centre

Focuses on getting kids back to doing what they love after sustaining a concussion, including recreational and competitive sports, through education, research and clinical services.

Centre for Leadership in Acquired Brain Injury

Supports the establishment of evidence-based rehabilitative care that promotes post-injury quality of life for children, families and communities.

Centre for Leadership in Child Development

Supports interdisciplinary research and evaluation of interventions for children and youth with neurodevelopmental disorders including cerebral palsy, autism spectrum disorders, spina bifida, neuromuscular disorders and more.

During that span, so much has advanced in care and research at Holland Bloorview, which in turn has translated into transformative changes in our kids and their families who took enormous steps forward in their recovery, abilities and outlook.

Beginning with a \$20 million endowment from The Holland Family, donors like you were integral partners in this campaign's success that provided both immediate funding to launch new strategic initiatives, as well as funding to support long-term term strategies and programs that will have a dramatic impact in the future.

This campaign has led to exciting new research in autism, with Holland Bloorview conducting the first drug trials for autism in the country.

We are developing innovative technologies that give a voice to non-verbal children with disabilities who are now well on their way to communicating independently with their families and friends.

We are continually revamping our Family Resource Centre to provide the best services and information on childhood disability to all of our families.

Committed to making a positive impact on the lives of kids with disabilities, Holland Bloorview Kids Rehabilitation Hospital Foundation launched its IMPACT Matching Campaign this spring. Three donors have generously agreed to match up to \$2.3 million in donations from the public, generating a possible \$4.6 million for kids with disabilities.

By giving to the IMPACT Matching Campaign, every donor's gift will be doubled to support Holland Bloorview's Impact Fund, which makes the following programs and services possible:

Transition to Adulthood: a new strategy to transform the journey to adulthood for kids with disabilities by breaking through barriers and developing new partnerships and programs.

Client and Family Centred Care Programs: including BLOOM, which provides information about caring for kids with special needs, and the Therapeutic Clown Program, which helps kids with pain management and provides warmth and laughter to clients, families and staff.

The Family Support Fund: financial aid for families of kids with special needs, including funds for special equipment, transportation and medications.

Music, Arts, Life Skills and Respite Services: programming that lets kids be expressive, creative and independent.

Centres for Leadership: through the integration of clinical, research and education initiatives, these Centres for Leadership advance care every day for kids with disabilities.

Through the IMPACT Matching Campaign, and the support of our generous donors, The Coriat Family, The Slaight Family Foundation and La Fondation Emmanuelle Gattuso, Holland Bloorview is creating a world of possibilities for kids with disabilities and will help them move forward with confidence, independence and pride.
