

## PACE Exchange Scenario Three: It's all in the data.

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As a senior leader in your organization you've noticed some alarming trends in your patient experience data that suggest your patients and their families have increasing concerns about patient safety, and some concurrent trends in your patient safety reporting that suggest your rates of falls have increased and your hand hygiene results have declined in each of the last 3 quarters.

What steps would you take to begin to address these areas of concern?

- 1. Discuss the case in your group and identify the issue.

- 3. How would we enact this improvement? (identify three key actions and consider what you will do, when, who will be engaged and how?)
- 3a) Action 1: What you will do? Working Group [ staff, senior leadership, quality and risk, patients, senior leadership] also to include data on falls and hand hygiene; determine what are the root causes from the data
